Cylch Meithrin Seiont and Pheblig is located at Noddfa Centre and is open for children between the ages of 2yrs and 3yrs. We have spaces for 26 children in both sessions, morning and afternoon

The aim of the Cylch Meithrin is to provide care and education through the medium of Welsh. We provide opportunities for children to develop to their full potential during their time at the Cylch by offering curriculum and learning strategies at their own pace e.g. learning through play. There are opportunity for every child under school age to take advantage of pre-school experience through the medium of Welsh. This gives the children experience to be creative, use their imagination and have fun while they learn.

Policies

When registering at the Cylch Meithrin, parents/guardians are informed of the 'Policies Folder' at the Cylch. This notes the policies and order of the Cylch for the following areas:

If your child cannot attend the Cylch to any reason, you will need to inform the Cylch as soon as possible.

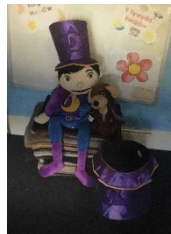

Each session cost is £9.50 per child. This will have to be paid in full at the beginning of each term. A café is available every day for the children to encourage health eating. The menu changes daily and the Cylch follows the Healthy pre-school plan and 'Healthy Bellies' (Boliau Iach).

During the day the children will have opportunities to do all sort of activities following the Curriculum for wales with in the moment planning. The children have the chance to be independent and work in groups inside or outside whatever the weather. All of the children's own work will be available to take home.

We use See Saw's communications platform and a parent group (Messenger) to communicate with parents and share information. Everyone's account will be private. The activities are child-led.

The Leader holds a file on each child and notes their attendance and development throughout the year. At the end of the year a report is presented to the parents/guardian on their child's development throughout all of the terms. The parents/guardians are welcome at any time to discuss the development of their child at the Cylch.
